

# Knit Your Stripes Blanket



**Size:** 50 x 68"/127x173cm

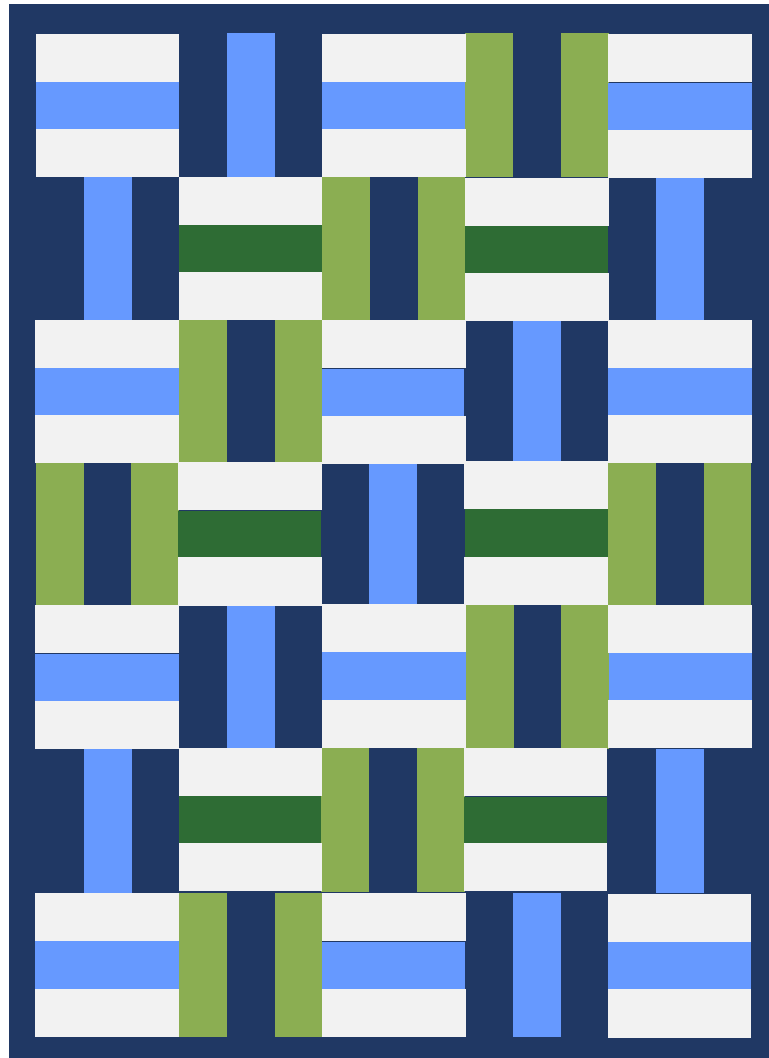
**Gauge:** 18 sts and 36 rows = 4"/10cm

**Needles:** US Size 7, 40"/100cm circular needles, or size to obtain gauge.

## Yarn requirements:

Any worsted weight yarn

- A** 960 yards (white)
- B** 560 yards (medium blue)
- C** 1000 yards (navy blue)
- D** 160 yards (dark green)
- E** 430 yards (avocado green)



## Pattern Stitches

**Block:** *Note: If desired, do not cut yarn after working first stripe, and at the beginning of each right side row of the middle stripe, twist together the working and non-working yarn.*

With A, [cast on](#) 42 stitches (sts), leaving a 30"/75cm tail.

[Knit](#) 28 rows.

Cut A. Attach B.

Knit 28 rows.

Cut B. Attach A.

Knit 28 rows.

[Bind off](#) loosely.

Cut yarn leaving 30"/75cm tail.

## Instructions:

Make 35 blocks, in quantities and color schemes 1 – 4 shown above.

## Assembly:

Arrange blocks into 5 vertical stripes, as shown in illustration. Using [whip st](#), sew blocks together using long tails. Sew vertical strips together, matching block corners.

## Borders:

**Right Border:** Attach C at bottom-right corner of assembled blanket. [Pick up and knit](#) (pu&k) 1 st per garter st ridge (42 sts per block) – 294 sts. Knit 11 rows. BO loosely.

**Left Border:** Rep as for Left Border, attaching yarn at top-left corner of assembled blanket.

**Top Border:** Attach C at top right corner of the Right Border. Pu&k 7 sts on the edge of the Right border, 210 sts across the blocks (42 sts per block) and 7 sts on the edge of the Left Border. Knit 11 rows. Bind off loosely.

**Bottom Border:** Rep as for Top Border, attaching yarn at the bottom-left edge of the Left Border.

**Finishing:** [Weave in ends](#), and if desired, block to measurements.
